Stationery requirements



Key Stage 3 - 5

As a fully online school, learners are expected to have the necessary stationery and subject-specific equipment available to complete handwritten notes, calculations, diagrams, and more before digitally submitting their work.

Standard stationery requirements

- Red pen (for self-assessment and corrections)
- Black or blue ballpoint pens
- Highlighters (recommended)
- HB pencils
- Eraser
- Pencil sharpener
- 30cm ruler
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- A4 notebook(s) or loose-leaf paper
- Ring binder or lever arch file for organising notes
- Plastic file pockets or subject dividers
- Sticky notes or page markers (optional)

Art & Design*

- A3 sketchbook (good quality textured paper)
- A range of graphite pencils (HB, 2B, 4B, 6B)
- Blending stump/tools
- Putty/kneadable eraser
- Ballpoint pens (blue/black/red)
- Charcoal pencil
- White gel pen
- Black Fineliners (3 different sizes)
- Good quality colouring pencils
- Set of acrylic paints
- Container for art supplies
- 3 round paintbrushes (small, medium, and large)
- Medium sized flat brush
- Good quality glue stick
- Pencil sharpener

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Mathematics

Learners are required to have a **non-programmable scientific calculator** that complies with Pearson Edexcel regulations.

- Recommended: Casio FX-82ZA PLUS II (recommended)

Suitable **international equivalents** include:

- Casio fx-82EX ClassWiz
- Casio fx-85GT CW
- Casio fx-991CW (where permitted for the relevant examination)
- Complete mathematical instrument set containing:
 - Compass and protractor
 - 45° and 60° set square

In addition to the above, learners must have:

- 30cm ruler
- HB pencils
- Eraser
- Graph paper (recommended)

French/Spanish/ Arabic

- Laptops/desktops must have a number pad for accent codes (or an external number pad that can be added via USB).
